

HR Colloquium

Reiterating its continuous contribution to the HR arena in the country, XIME organised a National Colloquium on 'HR: The Road Ahead' on 28 September 2013 in association with NHRD Bangalore Chapter. The colloquium saw twenty two distinguished speakers from leading industries discussing the challenges and direction of HR in this decade through a Delphi approach.


Dr. Masud M Arjmand
