### Spreading Joy on Children's Day

The XIME community celebrated Children's Day by visiting three NGOs—Pragathi, UPAY, and DSFS—engaging 140 children in a day with games, activities, and meaningful interactions.

The visit was all about spreading happiness and creating connections beyond everyday routines. The children's excitement and energy reminded us of the importance of giving back to the community, spreading joy through interactions.

### Life-Saving Skills for Emergencies

On 6 November, 2024, Xseed conducted a 'Hands-on CPR' workshop in collaboration with Dr. Nitin P. R. and his team from Narayana Hrudayalaya.

The session equipped students with vital skills to respond effectively to cardiac arrest emergencies by teaching them the essential steps of Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and the use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED).

Dr. Nitin shared some insights related to heart health and created awareness towards the multiple factors that lead to cardiac arrest. He revealed that cardiac arrest can also result from road accidents and highlighted the critical 'chain of survival':recognising cardiac arrest, activating emergency services, and administering CPR.









Participants learned essential techniques to be administered to patients during such situations like ensuring responsiveness, performing chest compressions, providing rescue breaths, and using AEDs.

He stressed the need for immediate action, explaining that a delay would result in brain damage within minutes in the absence of proper blood flow. Practical demonstrations aided students master effective compression depth, rate, and hand positioning.

On 7 November 2024, X-Oration hosted 'VERBARISE', an exciting competition that challenged participants' verbal skills in three rounds.
